Freedom of Information Request – Reference No:20191760

REQUEST

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, XXXXX XXXXX requests that the South Yorkshire Police produce a list of the titles (for documents without a title a brief record description) & creation dates of all documents or data sent to the South Yorkshire Police & Crime commissioner Advisory Panel on Policing Protests and the review into the policing of tree protests in Sheffield.

If any record or portion thereof is claimed to be exempt from production under FOI, sufficient identifying information (with respect to each allegedly exempt record or portion thereof) must be provided to allow the assessment of the propriety of the claimed exemption.

RESPONSE

South Yorkshire Police holds the information you request. However, as this is already freely available, we will not be supplying the information to you now

Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires South Yorkshire Police, when refusing to provide such information (because the information is exempt), to provide you the applicant with a notice which:

- a. states that fact,
- b. specifies the exemption in question and
- c. states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies).

The exemption applicable to your request falls under Section 21.

Section 21 '*Information which is reasonably accessible to the applicant*'.
