It was stated by contractors and SYP on site that an agreement had been reached between Sheffield City Council/Amey, South Yorkshire Police and South Yorkshire Fire and Rescue regarding not allowing members of the public to be on the land belonging to South Yorkshire Fire and Rescue.

It was stated that documentation had been signed between the parties involved around the 20th March 2018.

- 2. Any communications between SCC/Amey, SYP and SYFR in the preparation and discussion of preparation of the signed document. Please include any emails, phone records, records of meetings, notes etc.
- 3. A copy of any documents that were produced and not used or rejected by the other/either parties regarding the access of members of the public on the SYFR Rivelin Road site.
